To vacate that part of Maryland Avenue in the City of Bexley, Ohio, between the west line of North Parkview Avenue and Alum Creek and to repeal Ordinance No. 977 passed on December 11, 1928.

WHEREAS, on the 24th day of January, 1950, the petition and consent of the owners of all the lots and lands bounding and abutting upon that part of Maryland Avenue in the City of Bexley, Ohio, between the west line of North Parkview Avenue and Alum Creek was duly presented to Council praying that said part of Maryland Avenue be vacated by the said owners, and, WHEREAS, Council upon hearing is satisfied that there is good cause for said vacation as prayed for and that such vacation will not be detrimental to the general interest and, further, finds that said petition and consent have been signed by all of the owners of the lots and lands bounding and abutting upon said Maryland Avenue by the said owners, FOW,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That said part of said Maryland Avenue lying west of the west line of North Parkview Avenue and extending westerly sixty (60) feet in width to the west line of Lot Wumber One (1) of Block One (1) Bullitt Park Addition in said Village as shown on Plat Book 4, page 416, Recorder's Office, Franklin County, Ohio, a distance of 264.20 feet, more or less, and thence extending westerly thirty (30) feet in width along the south line of the subdivision of the estate of Anton Ruhl, as shown upon Plat Book 8, page 7-A, said Recorder's Office, to Alum Creek, be and the same is hereby vacated; reserving, however, to the city and public and quasipublic corporations now or hereafter holding franchises or permits from the City for the supplying of water, gas, electricity, and telephone service, all necessary easements in, under or over said premises for the purpose of maintaining, replacing, repairing and servicing any sewers, manholes, poles, conduits, wires or anchors now in or upon said premises.

Section 2. That Ordinance No. 977 passed on the 11th day of December, 1928, be and the same is hereby repealed.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
