

## RESOLUTION NO. 4-50

Appointing Boards to report estimated assessment to pay the cost and expense of improving the streets hereinafter named:

WHEREAS, it has been determined by Council to assess the cost of improving the following streets in proportion to the benefit which may result from said improvement, as follows, to-wit:

Pleasant Ridge Avenue from Francis Avenue to the south end of the present pavement, less 2% thereof and the cost of hydrants and intersections; North Stanbery Drive from Ruhl Avenue to Cassady Road, less 2% thereof and the cost of hydrants and intersections; Elm Avenue from Roosevelt Avenue to Gould Road, less 2% and cost of intersections; and Plymouth Avenue from Roosevelt Avenue to Merkle Road, less 2% and cost of intersections, NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That William Graessle, Carl Hall and Dana Whiting, three disinterested freeholders of the City, be and they are hereby appointed a Board to estimate the assessment of such cost on the lots and lands to be charged therewith, as set forth in the ordinances determining to proceed with the improvements of said Pleasant Ridge Avenue and Elm Avenue as hereinabove described; and Stan Bachman, Carl Johnson and James Dixey, three disinterested freeholders of the City, be and they are hereby appointed a Board to estimate the assessment of such cost on the lots and lands to be charged therewith, as set forth in the ordinance determining to proceed with the improvements of North Stanbery Drive and Plymouth Avenue, as hereinabove set forth; all in proportion as nearly as may be to the benefits which may result from the improvement to the several lots or parcels of lands so assessed, and to report to this Council the said estimated assessment.
