

RESOLUTION NO. 7-50

Appointing an Equalizing Board to hear objection to estimated assessments for the improvement of Pleasant Ridge Avenue from Francis Avenue to end of present pavement.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO: Two thirds of the members elected thereto concurring:

That Virgil Dassel, Frank Cain and Samuel Devine, three disinterested freeholders of the City, be and they are hereby appointed to act as an equalizing board to hear all objections to the estimated assessments heretofore reported to Council of the cost of improving Pleasant Ridge Avenue from Francis Avenue to the end of the present pavement, and to equalize the same as to them may seem proper, in accordance with law.

Said board shall meet for the above purpose at the Municipal Building at 2242 East Main Street, Bexley, Ohio, on the ____ day of _____, 1950, at _____ o'clock, P. M., and upon the completion of such equalization shall report such equalized assessment to Council.
