

ORDINANCE NO. 8-50

To levy special assessments for the construction of sanitary sewers in part of Sanitary Sewer District No. 5, being the territory now known as Robert Weiler's No. 1 Subdivision.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the assessment of the cost and expense of constructing the following described sanitary sewers in part of Sanitary Sewer District No. 5, said part being known as Robert Weiler's No. 1 Subdivision, as follows, to-wit:

(a) An eight inch sewer in the easement east of Roosevelt Avenue, from the present sewer in Powell Avenue to the first alley south of Broad Street;

(b) An eight inch sewer in the first alley south of Broad Street, from a point fifty feet east of Roosevelt Avenue to a point thirty feet south of Merkle Road; and

as provided in Resolution No. 3-46 to construct said sewers, adopted July 9, 1946, in the aggregate amount of \$8,800.00, as said assessment is reported to this Council on the 10th day of February, 1948, by the Board heretofore appointed to estimate said assessments, notice of the filing of which assessments has been given as required by law, be and the same is hereby adopted and confirmed, and that there be and is hereby levied and assessed upon the lots and lands bounding, fronting and abutting upon said improvement the several amounts reported as aforesaid, which said assessments together with the description of said lots and lands, are now on file in the office of the Clerk of this Council, and which assessments are in proportion to the special benefits, and are not in excess of the special benefits to said property, and are not in excess of any statutory limitation, said assessments, together with the description of said lots and lands, are as follows, to-wit:

Section 2. That the total assessments against each lot or parcel of land shall be payable in cash within thirty days from and after the passage of this ordinance, or at the option of the owner, in ten annual installments with interest on deferred payments

at the same rate as shall be borne by the bonds to be issued in anticipation of the collection of the same, to-wit: 3%. All cash payments shall be made to the Auditor of said City of Bexley. All assessments and installments thereof remaining unpaid at the expiration of said thirty days shall be certified by the Clerk of this Council to the County Auditor, as provided by law to be by him placed on the tax duplicate and collected as other taxes are collected.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
