

ORDINANCE NO. 9-50

To appropriate moneys for reimbursement of bond payment fund.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That there be and is hereby appropriated from the General Fund the sum of \$1,200.00 to reimburse the Bond Payment Fund for payments heretofore made to the Jennings-Lawrence Company, Engineers, for the preparation of preliminary plans for the proposed improvements of Charles Street and Caroline Avenue, together with interest thereon.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
