ORDINANCE NO. 13-50

By Mr. Park

Providing for vacation of municipal employees.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That every employee of the City of Bexley who is employed upon an hourly basis who has been in the employ of the City for at least one year prior thereto shall be entitled to a vacation of one-half day for each month that he has been so employed during the preceding twelve months' period, and he shall be entitled to pay during said vacation at the same rate of pay that he has received per hour for work during said preceding year, but not to exceed eight hours per day, the dates of said vacations, however, shall be subject to the approval of the Mayor.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
