

ORDINANCE NO. 21-50

Accepting the plat of William Yaekle Subdivision and confirming dedication of streets and avenues therein.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the plat of William Yaekle Subdivision, being a subdivision of 2.08 Acres, more or less, in the City of Bexley, Ohio, and being composed of the remaining part of the 5 Acre tract deeded to William Yaekle and Matilda Yaekle, his wife, as the same is shown of record in Deed Book 648, page 46, of the Recorder's Office, Franklin County, Ohio, be and the same is hereby approved and accepted, and that the dedication to public use of the streets and avenues thereon shown be and the same is hereby accepted and confirmed.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
