Providing for the purchase of materials for moving and reconstructing the Main Street lighting substation, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That it is hereby determined to be necessary to move and reconstruct the Main Street lighting substation now located on the property of the City at No. 2242 East Main Street, and the same shall be moved and reconstructed, in accordance with the plans, specifications, estimates and profiles now on file in the office of the Mayor, which are hereby approved.

Section 2. That the Mayor and Auditor be, and they are hereby, authorized and empowered to enter into a contract or contracts for the purchase of the following materials after advertisement according to law, for the use in said moving and reconstruction of said substation, to-wit:

Said materials shall comply with, and said work shall be done in accordance with said plans, specifications, estimates and profiles.

Section 3. That the sum of \$1,300.00 is hereby appropriated from the General Fund for the payment of the cost of said materials.

Section 4. This ordinance is an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that said substation is in an unsafe condition of repair, and this ordinance shall go into full force and effect upon its passage.
