Providing for the transfer of moneys from the General Fund to the Folice Relief and Pension Fund.

WHEREAS, Council has heretofore established a Police Relief and Pension Fund in accordance with the provisions of Section 4616 of the General Code, and,

whereas, Section 4621 of the General Code provides that Council shall each year, in the manner provided by law for making of other municipal levies and in addition to all other levies authorized by law, levy a tax of three-tenths of a mill on each dollar upon all the real and personal property as listed for taxation in the municipality for the purpose of providing funds for the payment of benefits and pensions from the Police Relief and Pension Fund as provided by law, and,

WHEREAS, Council failed to include such levy of a tax of threetenths of a mill on each dollar in its budget for the year 1948, and,

WHEREAS, all real and personal property as shown upon the Grand Duplicate of Franklin County for the year 1948 amounted to the total sum of \$26,990,180.00 and it is the orinion of Council that there should be transferred from the General Fund to said Police Relief and Pension Fund by reason of said omission to levy said tax the sum of \$8,000.00, which sum is not in excess of the amount that would have been produced by the levy of a tax of three-tenths of a mill upon said real and personal property as listed in said Grand Duplicate, NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That by reason of the omission of the levy of a tax of three-tenths of a mill on each dollar upon all the real and personal property as listed for taxation for the year 1948 to provide funds for the payment of police benefits and pensions, as provided by law, there be and there is hereby appropriated from the General Fund to the Police Relief and Pension Fund the sum of

\$8,000.00, and the Auditor is hereby authorized and directed to draw the necessary voucher and to make said transfer.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be inforce from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
