

## ORDINANCE NO. 24-50

By Mr. Linscott

Providing for the sale of the following personal property:  
Being the dwelling house at the rear of No. 2232 East Main  
Street.

WHEREAS, it is necessary to dispose of and remove the frame  
house, located in the rear of No. 2232 East Main Street for the  
purpose of clearing the ground preparatory to erecting the  
municipal office building, which frame house is not needed for  
municipal purposes, but shall be separated from the land and  
disposed of as personal property, the estimated value of which  
is less than \$500.00, NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor be and he is hereby authorized to  
obtain the highest bid he is able to obtain for said building,  
he to offer same either by advertising or personal solicitation  
as he may deem best, the terms of sale to be cash and under agree-  
ment that the purchaser shall remove said building from the  
premises on or before June \_\_\_\_\_, 1950.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force  
from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
