

ORDINANCE NO. 26-50

To amend Section 31 of Ordinance No. 47-36, being an ordinance to establish a Traffic Code for the City of Bexley, as said section is amended by Ordinance No. 2-44, and to repeal said section as amended.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That Section 31 of Ordinance No. 47-36 to establish a Traffic Code for the City of Bexley, as amended by Ordinance No. 2-44, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 31. The following streets and highways are hereby designated as through highways, to-wit:

- (a) East Broad Street from the West Corporation line to the East Corporation line.
- (b) East Main Street from the West Corporation line to the East Corporation line.
- (c) South Drexel Avenue from East Main Street to East Broad Street.
- (d) North Drexel Avenue from East Broad Street to the North Corporation line.
- (e) South Cassady Road from East Main Street to East Broad Street.
- (f) North Cassady Road from East Broad Street to North Corporation line.
- (g) South Parkview Avenue from East Main Street to East Broad Street.
- (h) North Parkview Avenue from East Broad Street to the North Corporation line.
- (i) College Avenue from East Main Street to South Corporation line.
- (j) South Cassingham Road from East Main Street to East Broad Street.
- (k) Dawson Avenue from Main Street to Fair Avenue.
- (l) Remington Road from Main Street to Fair Avenue.
- (m) Maryland Avenue from North Parkview Avenue to North Cassady Avenue.
- (n) Roosevelt Avenue from East Broad Street to East Main Street.
- (o) Mound Street from Sheridan Avenue to Chelsea Avenue.
- (p) Sheridan Avenue from Mound Street to Livingston Avenue.
- (q) Pleasant Ridge Avenue from Mound Street to Francis Avenue.
- (r) Francis Avenue from Mound Street to Livingston Avenue.

- (s) Euclaire Avenue from Mound Street to Livingston Avenue.
- (t) Cassingham Road from Mound Street to Livingston Avenue.
- (u) Montrose Avenue from Mound Street to Livingston Avenue.
- (v) Remington Road from Mound Street to Livingston Avenue.
- (w) Vernon Road from Mound Street to Livingston Avenue.
- (x) Roosevelt Avenue from Mound Street to Livingston Avenue.
- (y) Grandon Avenue from Mound Street to Livingston Avenue.
- (z) Chelsea Avenue from Mound Street to Livingston Avenue.

Also all state routes and all sections of Streets and Highways on which there are operated street cars, trackless trolleys, and other electric cars, or motor coaches for carrying passengers for hire along a fixed or regular route under authority granted by the municipality are also designated as through highways.

The Mayor shall erect stop signs on all streets and highways intersecting such through highways; provided, that where two or more through highways intersect and no traffic-control signal is in operation, stop signs shall be erected at one or more entrances thereto by the Mayor.

Every sign shall bear the word "Stop" in letters not less than six inches in height. Every stop sign shall be located as near as practicable at the property line of the highway at the entrance to which the stop must be made, or at the nearest line of the crosswalk thereat, or, if none, at the nearest line of the roadway.

Every operator of a vehicle, street car or trackless trolley shall stop at such sign or at a clearly marked stop line before entering an intersection except when directed to proceed by a police officer or traffic control signal.

Section 2. That Section 31 of Ordinance No. 47-36, as amended by Ordinance No. 2-44 be and the same is hereby repealed.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
