By Mr. Helmbrecht

To levy special assessments for the improvement of North Stanbery Drive, from Ruhl Avenue to Cassady Road, by grading and paving the roadway thereof with concrete foundation, with bituminous top, constructing curbs and gutters, the necessary drains to furnish proper drainage for such improvement, constructing sidewalks on each side thereof, and 6-inch cast iron water main, with water connections, hydrants and necessary appurtenances, and constructing sanitary connections from existing sanitary sewers to serve abutting properties.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the assessment of the cost and expense of improving North Stanbery Drive, from Ruhl Avenue to Cassady Road, by grading and paving the roadway thereof with concrete foundation, with bituminous top, constructing curts and gutters, the necessary drains to furnish proper drainage for such improvement, constructing sidewalks on each side thereof, and 6-inch cast iron water main, with water connections, hydrants and necessary appurtenances, and constructing sanitary connections from existing sanitary sewers to serve abutting properties, in the aggregate amount of \$28,600.00, as reported to this Council on the 23rd day of May, 1950, by the Board heretofore appointed to estimate said assessments, notice of the filing of which assessments has been given as required by law, be and the same is hereby adopted and confirmed, and that there be and is hereby levied and assessed upon the lots and lands bounding, fronting and abutting upon said improvement the several amounts reported as aforesaid, which assessments, together with the description of said lots and lands, are now on file in the office of the Clerk of this Council, and which assessments are in proportion to the special benefits, and are not in excess of any statutory limitations, said assessments, together with the description of said lots and lands, are as follows, to-wit:

Section 2. That the total assessment against each lot or parcel of land shall be payable in cash within thirty days from and after the passage of this ordinance, or, at the option of the owner, in ten annual installments with interest at the same rate as shall be borne by the bonds to be issued in anticipation of the collection of the same, to-wit: 2%. All assessments and installments thereof remaining unpaid at the expiration of said thirty days shall be certified by the Clerk of this Council to the County Auditor, as provided by law to be by him placed on the tax duplicate and collected as other taxes are collected.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
