

ORDINANCE NO. 30-50

Appropriating money to pay the City of Bexley's portion of the cost of reconstructing and enlarging the storm sewer used jointly by the City of Bexley and City of Columbus at the intersection of Livingston and College Avenues.

WHEREAS, the Director of Highways of the State of Ohio is in cooperation with the City of Columbus reconstructing and enlarging the 48 inch storm sewer at the intersection of Livingston and College Avenues in the City of Columbus which is used jointly by the cities of Bexley and Columbus, which said 48 inch sewer is now inadequate to receive the discharge of storm water from the 60 inch sewer entered therein from the City of Bexley, for which reason it is to the interest of the City of Bexley that the same be enlarged to 60 inches, and

WHEREAS, it is estimated that the City of Bexley should contribute to the City of Columbus 90% of the cost of such reconstruction and enlarging of said sewer under its contract with said Director of Highways, which 90% is estimated in the sum of \$6,000.00, Now Therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the City of Bexley shall pay to the City of Columbus the sum of \$6,000.00 to pay its portion of the cost of reconstructing and enlarging said 48 inch storm sewer under the contract for said improvement between the City of Columbus and the Director of Highways herein above described, said sum to be applied by said City of Columbus upon said cost of construction, any balance left from said sum, if any, at the completion of said work to be repaid to the City of Bexley. The sum of \$6,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the General Fund for the payment of cost and expenses herein above provided.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
