ORDINANCE NO. LOA-50

AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR A FORTY HOUR WORK WEEK FOR MEMBERS OF THE DIVISION OF POLICE.

WHEREAS:

To provide for a forty (40) hour work week and an eight (8) hour work day for the regular members of the Division of Police, Department of Public Safety, City of Bexley, Ohio.

SECTION 1. That on and after the effective date of this Ordinance no regular member of the Division of Police, Department of Public Safety shall work more than forty (40) hours in any one week. The schedule of work of said Division of Police shall be so arranged that regular members thereof shall not be required to work more than eight (8) conservative hours in a twenty-four (24) hour period. And so that not more than the periods, at a scale of wages not less than those received as of January 1, 1950.

SECTION 2. The requirements of Section 1 of this Ordinance shall not apply during periods of extraordinary emergency caused by fire, flood or similar extraordinary emergency condition. Be it further provided that, in cases of sickness or death, or other necessary occasion, the chief of the Division of Police may permit the the exchange of working hours between officers and regular members of the Division.

SECTION 3. Nothing contained in this Ordinance shall affect the provisions of any other existing Ordinance granting vacations, rates of pay or leaves of absence.

SECTION 4. No Provision of any other Ordinance shall be construed as authorizing any action inconsistent with the provisions of Section 1 hereof.

SECTION 5. That this Ordinance shall take effect at the earliest date permitted by law after adoption.

The above proposed Ordinance conforms with the conditions as set forth in Section 61 of the Charter of the City of Bexley, Ohio.

The above Ordinance was passed by the voters of the City of Bexley, Ohio, at the November election in 1950.
