

ORDINANCE NO. 2 -51

Providing for refund of \$42.00 to Ed Palmer for return of water meter. Whereas, on March 7, 1950, there was sold by the Department of Water to Ed Palmer, of 333 North Drexel Avenue, a one inch meter No. 1756130, for the sum of \$42.00, which was returned by said purchaser on March 30th by reason of the same being of too small a capacity, and a one and one-half inch meter No. 9220110 was substituted therefore at the price of \$83.16, and whereas said first said one inch meter was so sold by mistake, and Council being of the opinion that the cost thereof in the sum of \$42.00 should be refunded to said purchaser; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the sum of \$42.00 having been paid by the said Ed Palmer for said one inch meter, which was returned by him as aforesaid, and a new meter was sold in lieu thereof, the sum of \$42.00 is hereby refunded to said Ed Palmer, and the Auditor is authorized and directed to issue a proper voucher therefor.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
