RESOLUTION 3-51

Declaring it necessary to improve Ruhl Avenue from
Stanwood Road to the east corporation line of the City of Bexley,
by grading and paving the roadway thereof with concrete base
with bituminous surface, constructing concrete curbs and gutters,
necessary drains to provide drainage for said improvement, and
constructing concrete sidewalks on both sides thereof, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO: Three-fourths of all members elected thereto concurring:

from Stanwood Road to the east corporation line of the City of Bexley, by grading and paving the roadway thereof with concrete base with bituminous surface, constructing concrete curbs and gutters, necessary drains to provide drainage for said improvement, and constructing concrete sidewalks on both sides thereof, in accordance with the plans, specifications, estimates and profiles of the proposed improvement heretofore prepared by the engineers and now on file in the office of the Mayor, which plans, specifications, estimates are hereby approved.

Section 2. That the grade of said street and curbs as improved shall be as shown by the engineer's plans and profiles, which are made a part hereof, and which are on file in the office of the Mayor.

Section 3. That the entire cost of said improvement, less 25 percent thereof, which said 25 percent shall include the cost of intersections, shall be assessed in proportion to the benefits which may result from the improvement upon the following described lots and lands, to-wit: all lots and lands bounding and abutting upon said proposed improvement, which said lots and lands are hereby determined to be specially benefitted by said improvement, in an amount less than the cost thereof, and the cost of said improvement shall include the expense of the preliminary and other surveys, and of the printing and publish-

ing of notices, resolutions and ordinances required, the serving of said notices, the cost of construction, together with
interest on notes and bends issued in anticipation of the
collection of deferred assessments, and of all other necessary
expenditures.

Section 4. That the assessments so to be levied shall be paid in 10 annual installments with interest on deferred payments at the same rate as shall be borne by the bonds to be issued in anticipation of the collection thereof, provided that the owner of any property assessed may at his option pay such assessment in cash within thirty days after the passage of the assessing ordinance.

Section 5. That the bonds of the City of Bexley shall be issued in anticipation of the collection of the assessments by installments and in an amount equal thereto, and notes of said city shall be issued in anticipation of the issuance of such bonds.

Section 6. This resolution is an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that said street is in a condition dangerous to public traffic and should be immediately improved, and said resolution shall go into immediate force and effect.
