

ORDINANCE NO. 5 -51

To fix the compensation of the Solicitor.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the salary of the Solicitor shall be \$2,500.00 per annum, from January 1, 1951, payable monthly, for all services rendered as attorney and counsel for the City, and for all officers and departments thereof in matters relating to their official duties; provided, however, said Solicitor shall not be required to render service to said City or officials in any litigated matters for the salary and compensation aforesaid, but, in case his services should be required in any case or cases wherein said City or officials are involved, or about to be involved in litigation, he shall receive for such services such sum or sums as may be agreed upon by such Solicitor and the Council. The Solicitor shall give bond in the sum of \$500.00.

Section 2. That Ordinance No. 89-31, passed December 22, 1931, be and the same is hereby repealed.

Section 3. This Ordinance is an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and the same shall go into immediate force and effect.
