

ORDINANCE NO. 14 -51

Confirming an equalized assessment for the improvement of Pleasant Ridge Avenue.

Whereas, the Equalizing Board, heretofore appointed to hear and determine objections to the assessment for the improvement of Pleasant Ridge Avenue from Francis Avenue to the south end of the existing pavement, has reported to Council that after hearing all objections to said assessment, and having viewed the premises, upon consideration thereof, all members thereof being of the opinion that the lots and lands of said objectors, as well as all other abutting and assessed premises, are benefitted from said improvement in an amount at least equal to the assessments as heretofore reported by the Estimating Board, and that said reported assessments are in proportion to the benefits which will result to said lots and lands from said improvement, and submitted as an equalized assessment the same amounts against the same premises as are shown upon the assessment heretofore submitted by said Estimating Board, which assessment is now on file in the office of the Clerk; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO; two-thirds of the members of Council concurring:

Section 1. That the equalized assessment as reported to the Council on April 24, 1951 by the Equalizing Board, appointed to hear and determine objections to the assessment for the improvement of Pleasant Ridge Avenue from Francis Avenue to the end of the present pavement, said equalized assessment being in the same amounts against the same premises as are shown upon the assessment as submitted by the Estimating Board, and now on file in the office of the Clerk, be and the same is hereby confirmed.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
