

ORDINANCE NO. 11 - 51

To authorize payment of the claim of James Garrett.

Whereas, James Garrett, employed by the City as a laborer, was injured on February 22, 1951, by the explosion of a drum of asphaltic compound, which caused severe arm and body burns; and

Whereas, the said James Garrett has, through no fault of his own, by reason of said accident, suffered damages ~~in the sum of \$137.82~~ in the sum of \$137.82; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the claim of James Garrett in the amount of \$137.82 for injuries sustained on February 22, 1951, as hereinabove set forth, be and the same is hereby recognized as a moral obligation of the City.

Section 2. That the sum of \$137.82 is hereby appropriated from the general fund for the payment of said claim, and that the Auditor is authorized to issue his voucher in payment thereof upon receipt of a release properly executed by the said James Garrett of all damages arising out of said accident.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
