

ORDINANCE NO. 2-5 -51

To provide for the purchase of furniture and furnishings for the Municipal Building and the various offices therein contained.

IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor and the Auditor be and they are hereby authorized to advertise according to law for bids for furniture and furnishings to equip and furnish the Municipal Building and the various offices therein, in accordance with the specifications and estimates prepared by the architects and on file in the Office of the Mayor, which said specifications and estimates are hereby approved, such advertisement may be had and bids received from time to time for the various items contained in said specifications and estimates, or their equivalent, as may be designated by the Building Commission. The bids shall be tabulated by the architects and award of contract or contracts shall be made by the Building Commission. All contracts shall be entered into in the name of the City of Bexley, and shall be signed by the Mayor and Auditor.

Section 2. For the purpose of paying for said furniture and furnishings, there is hereby appropriated the following sums of money, to-wit:

From the General Fund \$ 156.00 .
From the Water Fund \$ 2.00 .

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
