

ORDINANCE NO. 28 - 51

Whereas, this council has heretofore by ordinance duly enacted provided for the purchase of a Packer type refuse truck, and therein authorized the Mayor and Auditor to enter into a contract therefor, advertising according to law, and

Whereas, such advertisement was had and bids were received for the purchase of a chassis or body separately and also for both, and

Whereas, the bid of The Columbus Truck and Equipment Company, Inc. was found to be the lowest and best bid for the chassis, being a 1951 Mack A-30H cab and truck chassis, for the price of \$4,408.00, less allowance of \$200.00 on a used truck belonging to the City, leaving a net bid of \$4,208.00, and a contract therefor was duly entered into with said The Columbus Truck and Equipment Company, Inc. on the 31st day of March, 1951, which contract called for delivery to be made according to the terms thereof on or before May 15, 1951, and

Whereas, a separate bid was received and let to Harry J. Reynolds and Associates, Inc. for the body for said truck, to be installed upon said chassis in accordance with the terms thereof, and

Whereas, said The Columbus Truck and Equipment Company, Inc. has wholly failed to make delivery of said chassis in accordance with said contract, and still refuses to make or promise such delivery; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized and directed to re-advertise for bids for a chassis for said Packer type refuse truck in accordance with the specifications now on file in the Office of the Mayor, and to enter into a contract with the lowest and best bidder according to law.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
