

ORDINANCE NO. 27 -51

Providing for the purchase of an automobile for the use of the Department of Public Safety, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor and Auditor be, and they are hereby authorized, to enter into a contract for the purchase of one new two-door sedan, with standard equipment, two windshield wipers, heavy duty generator adaptable to police cruiser work; heavy duty battery to operate radio and other equipment; spare wheel; heater; two arm rest; rear compartment or trunk space to accommodate Red Cross equipment, the same not to exceed \$2,500.00 in cost, and to exchange thereon one 1948 Chevrolet town sedan, Motor No. FAM 305968, Serial No. 2SJ12468, from which the present owner will remove the spot light, the siren and radio for installation in the automobile to be purchased.

Section 2. Said contract shall be entered into with the lowest and best bidder after advertisement according to law. The sum of \$2,500.00 is hereby appropriated from the Safety Fund for the purpose aforesaid.

Section 3. This ordinance is an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that the said Police Department is in need of said automobile for patrol duty, and said ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect.
