

ORDINANCE NO. 35-51

By A. C. Helmsbrucker

Providing for modification of salaries of certain appointive officials and employees and declaring an emergency.

Whereas, by reason of the present economic conditions Council deems it expedient and proper to provide for an increase in salaries of certain appointive officials and employees of the City hereinafter specifically set forth, NOW, THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That from and after December 1st, 1951, and until further action of Council, the salaries of the following appointive officials and employees shall be as follows per month, payable semi-monthly:

- (a) Chief of Police \$ 355-
- (b) Police Sergeants \$ 315-
- (c) Patrolmen - First 6 months \$ 270-
Second 6 months \$ 275-
Second year \$ 275-
Third year and thereafter \$ 300-
- (d) Equipment Maintenance Mechanic \$ 350-
- (e) Superintendent of Parks \$ 311-
- (f) Custodian of Jeffrey Property \$ 257-
- (g) Secretary to Mayor and Auditor \$ 220-
- (h) Superintendent of Streets \$ 450-
- (i) Superintendent of Building \$ 335-
- (j) Superintendent of Water \$ 310-
- (k) Director of Recreation - June, July, August \$ 3464
- (l) Director of Recreation (other 9 months of year) \$ 170.82
- (m) Secretary of the Board (Part time) \$ 13962

Section 2. This ordinance is an emergency measure, necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the city and shall be in full force and effect from and after the first day of December, 1951.
