

RESOLUTION NO. 1-52

By Mr. Park

To provide for lighting the streets and parts of streets in the City of Bexley hereinafter named, and levying and collecting special assessments therefore.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That, upon the recommendation of the Mayor, the Council does hereby declare it to be necessary to provide for lighting the streets and parts of streets herein in this section named, by laying underground cables, erecting the light standards, installing lamps, conduits, remodeling and enlarging the Cassingham School sub-station, and installing other necessary equipment, in accordance with the plans, specifications, estimates and profiles for said system of lighting prepared by the Engineers and now on file in the Office of the Mayor, and which are hereby approved; said streets and part of streets being as follows:

Section 2. That the whole cost of said improvement, less 19 per cent thereof, and the cost of intersections, which 19 per cent is in excess of 1/50th of said cost and the cost of intersections, shall be assessed in proportion to the benefits which may result from the improvement upon all the lots and lands bounding and abutting upon the proposed improvement, which said lots and lands are hereby determined to be specially benefitted by said improvement; and the cost of said improvement shall include the expense of the preliminary and other surveys and of printing and publishing the notices, resolutions and ordinances required, and the serving of said notices, the cost of construction together with interest on notes and bonds issued in anticipation of the collection of deferred assessments, and all other necessary expenditures.

Section 3. That the assessments so to be levied shall be paid in five annual installments, with interest on deferred payments at the same rate as shall be borne by the bonds to be issued in anticipation of the collection thereof; provided that the owner of any property assessed may, at his option, pay such assessment in cash within thirty days after the passage of the asssing ordinance.

Section 4. That the bonds of the City shall be issued in anticipation of the collection of assessments by installments and in an amount equal thereto; and notes of said City shall be issued in anticipation of the issue of such bonds.

Section 5. That the remainder of the entire cost of said improvement not specially assessed, including the cost of intersections, and any damages awarded any owner of adjoining lands and interest therein, and the cost and expense of such award shall be paid by the issuance of bonds in the manner provided by law.

Section 6. Notice of the passage of this Resolution shall be given to the owners of lots and lands to be assessed for the payment of the cost and expense of such lighting by posting copies thereof in not less than five of the most public places in the municipality, being the five places where notice of the passage of resolutions and ordinances are published as heretofore determined by Council, for a period of not less than fifteen days prior to the taking effect thereof, there being no two newspapers of opposite politics printed in the municipality, as defined in Section 6255 of the General Code.

Section 7. This resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
