

ORDINANCE NO. 8-52

BY MR. Sayer

Providing for purchase of two automobiles for use of the Department of Streets, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor and Auditor be, and they are hereby authorized to enter into a contract for the purchase of one new two-door coupe with standard equipment and one $\frac{1}{2}$ ton pick-up truck with standard equipment; each to have two windshield wipers, heater, spare wheel, each not to exceed \$3,000.00 in cost, and to exchange on the two-door coupe, one 1942 Chevrolet two-door coupe, Motor No. BA 288887, Serial #9BG12-7367 and to exchange on the pick-up truck, one 1938 Ford pick-up truck, Motor No. 4398946, 112 pick-up truck Model 85.

Section 2. Said contract shall be entered into with the lowest and best bidder after advertisement according to law. The sum of \$6,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the General Fund for the purposes aforesaid.

Section 3. This ordinance is an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that the said Street Department, is in need of said automobiles. Said ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect.
