ORDINANCE NO. 10 -52

Determining to proceed with the improvement of Merkle Road, from Maryland Avenue to the north line of J. L. Davis' First Addition, being the north end of the present pavement, in the manner hereinafter described, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO: Three-fourths of all members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That it is hereby determined to proceed with the improvement of Merkle Road, from Maryland Avenue to the north line of J. I. Davis' Addition, being the north end of the present pavement, by grading and paving the roadway thereof with concrete base, with bituminous concrete surface, constructing concrete curbs and gutters, necessary drains to provide drainage for said improvement, an eight inch sanitary sewer with extensions for house services, water main with water connections or taps, valves and necessary fire hydrants, and constructing sidewalks on each side thereof, in accordance with the plans, specifications, estimates and profiles of the proposed improvement heretofore prepared by the engineers and now on file in the Office of the Mayor.

Section 2. That all claims for damages resulting therefrom shall be judicially inquired into after the completion of the proposed improvement, and that the Mayor be and he is hereby authorized and directed to institute proceedings in a court of competent jurisdiction to inquire into such claims.

Section 3. That the entire cost of said improvement, less 2% thereof and the cost of intersections and fire hydrants, shall be assessed in proportion to the benefits which may result from the improvement upon the following described lots and lands, to-wit: all lots and lands bounding and abutting upon said proposed improvement, which said lots and lands are hereby determined to be specially benefitted by said improvement, in an amount not less than the cost thereof, and the cost of said improvement shall include the expense of the proliminary and other surveys, and of the printing and publishing of notices, resolutions and ordinances required, the serving of said notices, the cost of construction, together with interest on notes and bonds issued in anticipation of the collection of deferred assessments, and of all other necessary expenditures.

Section 4. That the assessments so to be levied shall be paid in 10 annual installments with interest on deferred payments at the same rate as shall be borne by the bonds to be issued in anticipation of the collection thereof, provided that the owner of any property assessed may at his critical pay such assessment in cash within thirty days after the passage of the assessment.

Section 5. That the bonds of the City of Bexley shall be assessments by installments and is an amount equal thereto, and notes of said City shall be issued in anticipation of the issuance of such bonds.

Section 6. That the remainder of the entire cost of said improvement shall be paid by the City, for which purpose the sum of \$850.00 is hereby appropriated from the general fund.

Section 7. That the Mayor and Auditor be and they are hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract for the making of said improvement after advertisement according to law.

Section 8. This ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency

being that said street is in a condition dangerous to public traffic and should be immediately improved, and said ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect.
