

ORDINANCE NO. 8 -52

Providing for the position of Custodian of the Municipal Building, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the position of Custodian of the Municipal Building is hereby created, which position shall be exempt from the classified service. Said Custodian shall be appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by Council for the remainder of the year ending December 31, 1952, and thereafter such appointment shall be for a term of one year.

Section 2. It shall be the duty of the Custodian to keep the Municipal Building clean and free from debris and dirt, and to perform all duties usually performed by janitors, all to the satisfaction of the Mayor; and said Custodian may be removed by the Mayor for cause.

Section 3. The salary shall be at the rate of \$250.00 per month, payable semi-monthly in installments of \$125.00 each. Said monthly salary shall be payable \$200.00 out of the General Fund and \$50.00 out of the Water Works Fund.

Section 4. This ordinance is an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, in the daily operation of the various city departments, and the same shall go into full force and effect upon its passage.

Section 4. This ordinance is an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, in the daily operation of the various city departments, and the same shall go into full force and effect upon its passage.
