To amend Section 5 of Ordinance No. 7-52, passed February 14, 1952.


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That Section 5 of Ordinance No. 7-52, To provide for the issue of notes in anticipation of the levy of special assessments and in anticipation of the issuance of bonds in anticipation of the collection of special assessments for the improvement to provide for lighting the streets and parts of streets as provided in Resolution No. 1-52, be and the same is amended to read as follows:

"Section 5. Such notes shall be executed by the Mayor and City Auditor, and shall bear the seal of the corporation; if requested by the successful bidder or bidders, they shall have interest coupons attached bearing the facsimile signature of the City Auditor; they shall be designated 'Street Lighting Improvement Notes', and shall be payable at the office of the Auditor in the City of Bexley, Ohio; they shall express upon their face the purpose for which they are issued and that they are issued pursuant to this ordinance."

Section 2. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period provided by law.
