

ORDINANCE NO. 29-52

Providing penalty for failure to file application for registration of motor vehicle.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. Whoever, being the owner or chauffeur of a motor vehicle operated or driven upon a public street, highway or alley in the City of Bexley, fails to file, or cause to be filed, with the State Registrar of motor vehicles, or deputy registrar, annually the application for registration required by law, shall upon conviction thereof, be fined not more than twenty-five dollars, and shall pay the costs of prosecution.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
