

ORDINANCE NO. 30-52.

By Mr. Park

Prohibiting the operation of motor vehicle with number of former owner,  
and providing penalty therefor.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. Whoever operates or drives upon the streets, highways or  
alleys of the City of Bexley, a motor vehicle acquired from a former owner who  
has registered the same, displaying thereon the distinctive number or identifica-  
tion mark assigned to such motor vehicle on such original registration, shall  
upon conviction thereof be fined not to exceed twenty five dollars for the first  
offense, and not to exceed fifty dollars for a subsequent offense, and shall  
pay the costs of prosecution.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and  
after the earliest period allowed by law.
