Providing for medification of salaries of certain appointive officials and employees and declaring an emergency.

Whereas, by reason of the present economic conditions Council deems it expedient and proper to provide for an increase in salaries of certain appointive officials and employees of the City hereinafter specifically set forth, NOW, THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That from and after September 15, 1952, and until further action of Council, the salaries of the following appointive officials and employees shall be as follows per month, payable semimonthly:

- (a) Chief of Police \$380.00
- (b) Police Sergeants \$337.00
- (c) Patrolmen First 6 Months \$290.00

Second 6 Months \$295.00

Second Year \$305.00

Third Year and Thereafter \$320.00

- (d) Equipment Maintenance Mechanic \$370.00
- (e) Superintendent of Parks \$331.00
- (f) Custodian of Jeffrey Property \$277.00
- (g) Secretary to Mayor and Auditor \$240.00
- (h) Superintendent of Streets \$500.00
- (i) Assistant Superintendent of Streets \$310.00
- (j) Superintendent of Building \$355.00
- (k) Superintendent of Water \$330.00
- (1) Director of Recreation June, July, August \$361.64
- (m) Director of Recreation (Other 9 months of year \$181.00
- (n) Secretary of the Board (Fart time) \$152.00
