

ORDINANCE NO. 34-52

Providing for the employment of special counsel for the prosecution of the case of City of Bexley vs. Adams Dunn, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That Dayre, an attorney-at-law, be and he is hereby appointed special council to conduct the prosecution to its final conclusion, of the case of City of Bexley vs. Adams Dunn, now pending in the Mayor's Court.

Section 2. The sum of \$ 500 is hereby appropriated from the general fund for payment for such legal services in said Mayor's Court.

Section 3. This ordinance is an emergency ordinance, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace and safety for the reason said prosecution is now pending, and the same shall go into full force upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
