

ORDINANCE NO. 14 -53

Authorizing payment of bill of Gibson-Stewart Company for repairing Oliver Cletrac Tractor with bullclam.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That whereas, the Oliver Cletrac Tractor, with bullclam, which is used daily for the covering of garbage and rubbish became inoperative and in need of extensive repairs in order to maintain the same in operation and to properly dispose of garbage and rubbish and thereby creating an emergency, and whereas the Gibson-Stewart Company is the only available place where said repairs could be made, the amount of which repairs could not be ascertained before said work was undertaken, all of which facts rendered it impracticable and useless to advertise for bids for said repairs, and whereas said repairs have been completed and a bill has been rendered for said services in the sum of \$2373.35, and

Whereas, Council finds that an emergency existed in that it was necessary to have said repairs immediately in order to properly dispose of the garbage and rubbish and prevent a serious hazard to the public health, and that said bill should be paid, and Council hereby approves said bill, and the sum of \$2373.35 is hereby appropriated from the General Fund for the payment thereof.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after the earliest period provided by law.
