

ORDINANCE NO. 17~~16~~-53

Accepting deed of Frank E. and Bertha I. Tartal, for opening and extending Gould Road in the City of Bexley, Ohio.

WHEREAS, Frank E. and Bertha I. Tartal, husband and wife, have executed their certain quit claim deed to the City of Bexley for the purpose of opening and extending Gould Road, the premises therein conveyed being described as follows, to-wit:

Being a strip of land twenty five (25) feet in width off the east end of a 0.54 acre tract conveyed to Frank E. and Bertha I. Tartal by Helen and Michael J. Crook as the same is of record in Deed Book 1510, Page 303, Recorder's Office, Franklin County, Ohio, said 25 foot strip of land beginning at the north line of Maryland Avenue and extending northwardly a distance of one hundred and seventy (170) feet to the corporation line between the City of Bexley and the City of Columbus, Ohio, and

Whereas, it will be for the best interest of the said City to accept said deed and conveyance for the use and purpose therein mentioned, NOW, THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That said deed of Frank E. and Bertha I. Tartal, bearing date of November 7, 1952, conveying to the City of Bexley the real estate hereinabove described, be and the same is hereby accepted, and the Clerk of Council is hereby directed to certify upon said deed the acceptance thereof by Council and to file same for record in the Recorder's Office of Franklin County, Ohio, and he is directed to send a certified copy of this Ordinance to the Auditor of Franklin County, Ohio.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
