

ORDINANCE NO. 22-53

By Mr. Hunt

To designate non-parking areas on Mound Street at its intersection with Pleasant Ridge Avenue, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That in addition to the non-parking areas established by Section 66 of Ordinance No. 30-51, the following areas are hereby designated as non-parking areas, and no person shall stand, or park a vehicle therein, unless in compliance with the directions of a police officer or a traffic control device:

(a) Mound Street, the north side thereof, from west curb line of Pleasant Ridge Avenue to a point 75 feet west thereof.

(b) Mound Street, the north side thereof, from the east curb line of Pleasant Ridge Avenue to a point 75 feet east thereof.

(c) Mound Street, the south side thereof, from the west curb line of Pleasant Ridge Avenue to a point 75 feet west thereof.

Section 2. Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine of not to exceed fifty dollars, and shall pay the costs of prosecution.

Section 3. This ordinance is an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, the emergency being that a dangerous traffic condition exists at the above locations, and said ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect.
