Requiring all vehicles to stop at all entrances to the street intersections hereinafter set forth, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. Whereas, by reason of the location of schools at the intersections hereinafter set forth, and hazardous traffic conditions exist at each thereof to both vehicular and pedestrian traffic, to-wit:

- (a) The intersection of Maryland Avenue and Cassingham Road
- (b) The intersection of Mound Street and Pleasant Ridge Avenue

The operator of any vehicle on any intersecting highway at any such intersection shall bring his vehicle to a full stop before crossing or entering upon such intersection; subject however, to the direction of any police officer or traffic control signal at such intersection.

The Mayor shall erect stop signs on all highways entering any such intersection, at the entrance thereto. Every such sign shall bear the word "STOP" in letters not less than six inches in height. Every stop sign shall be located as near as practicable at the property line of the highway at such entrance at which the stop must be made, or at the nearest line of the crosswalk thereat, or if none, at the nearest line of the roadway.

Section 2. The foregoing provisions shall in no way be construed to designate any of the above named highways as "through highways", as defined in Section 61 of Ordinance No. 30-51.

Section 3. Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine of not to exceed fifty dollars, and shall pay the costs of prosecution.

Section 4. This ordinance is an emergency measure, necessary for the public peace, health and safety, in that by reason of the location of schools at said intersections the same are hazardous both to pedestrian and vehicular traffic, and said ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect.
