

ORDINANCE NO. 25- 53

Providing for vacations for city employees having a record of five years, or more, of full time continuous employment on an hourly basis.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO.

Section 1. That in lieu of any other provision made by ordinance for vacations of employees of the City, all full time employees who have been continuously employed by the City on an hourly basis for a period of five years prior to December 31st, 1953, and all such employees who thereafter shall attain credit for five or more years of such full time continuous employment, shall be entitled to an annual vacation of two weeks with pay at the same rate per hour as he was entitled to receive at the time of the commencement of such vacation, for such number of hours per week as is provided by the pay schedule pertaining to his employment which was in effect during the greater portion of the year ending at the time such vacation is taken.

Section 2. That, in order that such vacation may not unduly interfere with the daily operation of the services and functions of the City the time of such vacation of each such employee shall be fixed by the Superintendent of the city department in which such employee is employed, subject to the approval of the Mayor. Upon approval of such Superintendent such vacation may be taken in two or more installments, but not to exceed a total of two weeks.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after January 1, 1954.
