## ORDINANCE NO. 29-53

To reappropriate moneys from the various appropriations within the General Fund to the various appropriations within said Fund for the current operations of the several governmental departments, as herein specified, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

- Section 1. That the following sums be reprpropriated from the various appropriations within the General Fund to the appropriations within said fund hereinafter set forth, for the current operation of the various departments herein shown, to-wit:
- (2) \$1,000.00 from the LE2 appropriation to the LE1 appropriation in the Jeffrey Mansion Func.
- (b) \$2,000.00 from the 1E6 appropriation to the 1E1 appropriation in the Jeffrey Mansion Fund.
- (c) \$3,000.00 from the 4 KlO appropriation to the 4 K6 appropriation in the Refuse Collection Fund.
- (d) \$2,500.00 from the 4L6 appropriation to the 4L1 appropriation in the Street Repair Fund.
- (e) \$100.00 from the 1535 appropriation to the 1536 appropriation in Park Fund.
- Section 2. That the following sums be reappropriated from the various appropriations within the Water Fund to the appropriations herein set forth within said Water Fund for the current operation of the water department:
- (a) \$200.00 from the 6A3 appropriation to the 6A4 appropriation within the Water Fund.
- (b) \$200.00 from the 6A3 appropriation to the 6A1 appropriation in Water Fund.
- Section ? Lat the following sums be reappropriated from the various appropriation, within the Granline Tax Street Repair Fund to the appropriations herein set forth within said Fund for the current operation of said Street Repair department:
- (a) \$3000.00 from the 1209 appropriation to the 12A6 appropriation within said Gasoline Tax Street Repair Fund.
- (b) \$500.00 from the 12All appropriation to the 12A7 appropriation within said Gaseline Tax Street Repair Fund.

Section 4. That the sum of \$100.00 be reappropriated from the 18A4 appropriation within the Police Pension Fund to the 18A5 appropriation within said fund for the current operation of said Fund.

Section 5. This ordinance is an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety in the daily operation of various city departments, and the same shall go into full force and adoption upon the approval thereof.
