

ORDINANCE NO. 33-53

Providing for bond of the Justice of the Peace for Bexley Township,
Franklin County, Ohio.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. Within ten days after taking the oath of office, each justice of the peace for Bexley Township, before he is authorized to discharge the duties of his office, shall give a bond to the State of Ohio, of not less than \$ 1000.00, with at least two sufficient sureties. Such bond shall be conditioned that such justice shall pay over according to law all money which comes into his hands by virtue of his commission, and faithfully perform every ministerial act enjoined upon him. If such justice fails to give such bond, the office shall be vacant, and the Council shall fill the vacancy as provided by law.

Section 2. The Auditor shall forthwith notify the clerk of the court of common pleas of Franklin County, Ohio, in writing of such filing of said bond, giving the date of filing.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
