

RESOLUTION NO. L-54

Approving bond of William Mauk as Justice of the Peace of Bexley Township.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. THAT, WHEREAS, William Mauk was on the 3rd day of November, 1953, duly elected Justice of the Peace of Bexley Township for the term of four years, commencing on the 1st day of January, 1954 and ending on the 31st day of December, 1957, and has presented his bond for the faithful performance of his duties as Justice of the Peace in the penal sum of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) with National Surety Corporation, as surety thereon, and said bond appearing to be in all respects in accordance with the Statutes, the same is hereby approved and the Clerk of Council is hereby authorized to enter said approval thereon.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Clerk be and he is hereby directed to file and deposit said bond in his office, and forthwith notify the Clerk of Common Pleas in writing of such filing, giving the date of filing.

Section 2. This resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
