

ORDINANCE NO. 3-54

To levy special assessments for the improvement to provide for lighting certain streets and parts of streets in the City of Bexley, Ohio, as provided by Ordinance No. 15-52, passed February 26, 1952.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the assessment of the cost and expense of the improvement to provide for lighting the streets and parts of streets in the City of Bexley, as provided by Ordinance No. 15-52, passed February 26, 1952, in the aggregate amount of \$167,085.00, as reported to this Council on the 29th day of January, 1954, by the Board heretofore appointed to estimate said assessments, notice of the filing of which assessments has been given as required by law, be and the same is hereby adopted and confirmed, and that there be and is hereby levied and assessed upon the lots and lands bounding and abutting upon said improvement the several amounts reported as aforesaid, which assessments, together with the description of said lots and lands, are now on file in the office of the Clerk of this Council, and which assessments are in proportion to the special benefits, and are not in excess of the special benefits to said property, and are not in excess of any statutory limitation, said assessments, together with the description of said lots and lands, are as follows, to-wit:
