

RESOLUTION NO. 6-54

Granting a license to Elton E. Evans and Edna I. Evans to erect a fence and plant shrubbery at the north line of the alley north of Lot 17 of Bexley Heights Addition in the City of Bexley.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

That whereas the property of Elton E. Evans and Edna I. Evans, being Lot No. 17 of Bexley Heights Addition, is bordered on the north by an unimproved 20 foot alley, the north line of which is the south line of the right of way of the Pittsburgh, Columbus, Cincinnati & St. Louis Railroad Company and the Baltimore & Ohio Railroad Company, and said owners have made application to Council for a license to erect a solid board fence not to exceed 6 feet in height and to plant shrubbery along said north line of said alley and to sow grass and attend the same in the roadway of said alley so as to beautify the same and to protect their said property from the annoyance caused by the proximity of said railroad; and

Whereas said alley has not been improved and is not in general use by the public and it is not the present intention of Council to improve the same, and the Council is of the opinion that such a license should be granted, the Council does hereby grant unto said Elton E. Evans and Edna I. Evans, their heirs, successors and assigns, a license to construct such fence and plant shrubbery along said north line of said alley, also to plant and care for grass in the roadway thereof, and to maintain said improvements until such time as Council may determine to open said alley and improve the same for public use, at which time, upon demand of Council, said licensees shall remove such fence and shrubbery.

This resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

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BE IT RESOLVED, that:

WHEREAS, there is in the treasury to the credit of the Bond Payment Fund as of this date a cash balance of \$99,993.94, of which amount the sum of \$12,046.61 was received for the payment of interest and/or principal of outstanding bonds, or funded debt, and the balance thereof in the sum of \$87,947.33 is not required for the payment of interest or principal of the City's bonds or funded debt, and was not raised for that purpose, but is required for general fund purposes, the Auditor is authorized to transfer the sum of \$80,000.00 from said Bond Payment Fund to the General Fund.
