

ORDINANCE NO. 13-54

Providing for the construction of a 6 inch water main for the purpose of furnishing fire protection for the Jeffrey House, located on the Jeffrey Estate, and declaring an emergency:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That for the purpose of furnishing water for fire protection to the Jeffrey House, located on the Jeffrey Estate, heretofore dedicated to the City for public purposes, it is necessary to construct and there shall be constructed, a 6 inch cast iron pipe water main, with the necessary appurtenances, fire hydrants, and valves, beginning at an existing 6 inch water main at the north end of the most westerly private drive in Sessions Village in the City of Bexley, Ohio, and proceeding northerly in an easement across the property of Rachel H. Fulton to Clifton Avenue; thence continuing northerly across Clifton Avenue to a point within the grounds of the Jeffrey Estate; thence turning northeasterly toward the Jeffrey House located on said estate to a point approximately 180 feet southerly from the southwesterly rear steps of said Jeffrey House; thence turning easterly and proceeding to a connection with the existing 6 inch water main in Parkview Avenue at a point 335 feet north of Clifton Avenue. At points in the above described 6 inch water main approximately opposite the southwest and northeast corners of said Jeffrey House a 6 inch water main shall be extended northerly to fire hydrants to be placed near the building at points accessible from existing roads around said building.

Said improvement shall be in accordance with the plans, profiles, specifications and estimates prepared by the Engineers and on file in the office of the Mayor.

Section 2. That the Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to enter into a contract for the construction of said water main after the advertisement according to law.

Section 3. That the sum of \$13,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the Water Fund to pay for the costs and expenses of said improvement.

Section 4. This ordinance is an emergency ordinance, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that said Jeffrey House is without adequate supply of water for fire protection, and said ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect.
