

ORDINANCE NO. 16-54

To designate non-parking areas on Mound Street, between Euclaire Avenue and College Avenue, and to repeal Ordinance No. 22-53.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That in addition to the non-parking areas established by Section 66 of Ordinance No. 30-51, the following areas are hereby designated as non-parking areas, and no person shall stand, or park a vehicle therein, unless in compliance with the directions of a police officer or a traffic control device:

(a) The north side of Mound Street, from Euclaire Avenue to College Avenue.

(b) The south side of Mound Street, from the west curb line of Pleasant Ridge Avenue to a point 75 feet west thereof.

Section 2. Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine of not to exceed fifty dollars, and shall pay the costs of prosecution.

Section 3. That Ordinance No. 22-53 is hereby repealed.

Section 4. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
