

ORDINANCE NO. 30-54

To designate non-parking area on the east side of Cassady Road from the first alley north of Main Street north to Sherwood Road, and fifteen (15) minute limited parking on the west side from Main Street to Sherwood Road, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That in addition to the non-parking areas established by Section 66 of Ordinance No. 30-51, the following area is hereby designated as a non-parking area, and no person shall stand, or park a vehicle therein, unless in compliance with the directions of a police officer or a traffic control device:

(a) Cassady Road, the east side thereof, from the first alley north of Main Street, north to Sherwood Road.

Section 2. That in addition to the limited parking areas established by Section 67 of Ordinance No. 30-51, the following area is hereby designated as a limited area.

(a) Cassady Road, the west side thereof, from Main Street, north to Sherwood Road, such parking shall not exceed fifteen minutes.

Section 3. Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine of not to exceed fifty dollars, and shall pay the costs of prosecution.

Section 4. This ordinance is an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, the emergency being that a dangerous traffic condition exists at the above location, and said ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect.
