

ORDINANCE NO. 31-54

To reappropriate moneys from the various appropriations within the General Fund to the various appropriations within said Fund for the current operations of the several governmental departments, as herein specified, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the following sums be reappropriated from the various appropriations within the General Fund to the appropriations within said fund hereinafter set forth, for the current operation of the various departments herein shown, to-wit:

(a) \$100.00 from the 1C4 appropriation to the 1C5 appropriation in the Mayor's Fund.

(b) \$1,000.00 from the 1M3 appropriation to the 1M5 appropriation in the Recreation Fund.

(c) \$400.00 from the 2C9 appropriation to the 2C10 appropriation in the Safety Fund.

Section 2. That the following sums be reappropriated from the various appropriations within the Service Fund to the appropriations within said fund hereinafter set forth, for the current operation of the various departments herein shown, to-wit:

(a) \$7,000.00 from the 4T6 appropriation to the 4T9 appropriation in the Sewer Fund.

(b) \$500.00 from the 4C8 appropriation to the 4C7 appropriation in the City Hall Fund.

Section 3. That the following sums be reappropriated from the various appropriations within the Water Fund to the appropriations herein set forth within said Water Fund for the current operation of the water department:

(a) \$100.00 from the 6A5 appropriation to the 6A4 appropriation in the Water Fund.

Section 4. That the following sums be reappropriated from the various appropriations within the Gasline Tax Street Repair Fund to the appropriations herein set forth within said Fund for the current operation of said Street Repair department:

(a) \$1,500.00 from the 12A7 appropriation to the 12A8 appropriation in the Gasline Tax Street Repair Fund.

Section 5. That the sum of \$200.00 be reappropriated from the 18A2 appropriation within the Police Pension Fund to the 18A4 appropriation within said fund for the current operation of said Fund.

Section 6. This ordinance is an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety in the daily operation of various city departments, and the same shall go into full force and adoption upon the approval thereof.
