

ORDINANCE NO. 2-55

Authorizing the purchase of two trucks for municipal purposes and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor and the Auditor be and they hereby are authorized to enter into a contract for the purchase of one three-quarter ton truck, to have pick-up body and standard equipment including heater, defroster and directional lights and to exchange thereon one 1939 Chevrolet pick-up truck, Motor No. K2219307, Serial No. IJC 012171 and for the purchase of one three-quarter ton truck, to have pick-up body and standard equipment including heater, defroster and directional lights and to exchange thereon one 1941 Hudson Coupe, Motor No. 1073853, Serial same.

Section 2. Said contract shall be entered into with the lowest and best bidder after advertisement according to law. The sum of \$2200.00 is hereby appropriated from the General Fund for the purchase of the first truck and the sum of \$2200.00 is hereby appropriated from the Water Fund for the purchase of the second truck.

Section 3. This ordinance is an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that said trucks are necessary for the daily operations of the city's governmental functions and said ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect.
