

RESOLUTION NO. 3 -55

Declaring it necessary to hold a public hearing to consider the proposed amendments to Ordinance No. 456.

Whereas, an ordinance has been prepared and submitted to the Planning Commission, which ordinance contains several amendments to our present zoning ordinance; and

Whereas, the Planning Commission met in regular session on Monday, July 25, 1955 and approved said ordinance; and

Whereas, under the Ohio law it is necessary to hold a public hearing and to give thirty days notice of the ~~same~~ time and place of said hearing in a newspaper of general circulation in this city; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That a public hearing be held on September 13, 1955 at 7:00 P.M. in the city Municipal Building to discuss and consider the proposed ordinance to repeal Article 1 and Sections 2, 7 and 8 of Ordinance No. 456 and to enact a new Article 1 and new Sections 2, 7 and 8 as provided in said ordinance.

Section 2. That the clerk give at least thirty days notice of the time and place of said meeting in a newspaper of general circulation in this city.

Section 3. That, from the date of the notice until the date of the hearing, a copy of the proposed ordinance and the report submitted by the Planning Commission shall be on file, for public examination, in the office of the Mayor.
