

ORDINANCE NO. 5-55

To repeal Section 2. of Ordinance No. 23-54 and to pass a new section to be known as Section 2. of Ordinance No. 23-54, which ordinance fixes and provides for the collection of a sewerage charge in the City of Bexley, Ohio, and declaring an emergency.

Whereas, Section 2. provides, among other things, that the funds shall be deposited to the General Fund; and

Whereas, under Section 729.52 of the Revised Code, all such funds shall be deposited in a separate fund known as the "Sewer Fund", Now, Therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That Section 2. of Ordinance No. 23-54 be and the same is hereby repealed and that a new Section 2. be and the same is hereby approved to read as follows:

Section 2. That the funds received from the collection of such charges, as hereinafter authorized, shall be deposited daily with the City Auditor and shall be by him deposited to a fund known as the "Sewer Fund", and when appropriated by the Council of the City of Bexley, shall be available for the payments becoming due to the City of Columbus under the terms of said agreement or agreements with said city for the distribution, transportation, pumping and treatment of sanitary sewage, and shall be available for the payments of any bills for labor or material incurred by the City of Bexley in the construction, maintenance or repair of the sewer system in the City of Bexley.

Section 2. That City Auditor is hereby authorized and directed to transfer to the Sewer Fund all funds received by him for sewer charges which have been paid and deposited in the General Fund.

Section 2. This ordinance is an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety, said emergency being that it is necessary to properly deposit and disburse said funds so that the laws of the State of Ohio will not be violated, and the same shall be in full force and effect upon its passage.
