

ORDINANCE NO. 19-55

To amend Section 66 of Ordinance 30-51, being an ordinance to establish a Traffic Code for the City of Bexley, Ohio, and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That Section 66, Non-Parking Areas, Paragraph 23, of Ordinance No. 30-51, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

(23) Cassingham Road, from Powell Avenue to the first alley north of Fair Avenue; east side thereof.

Section 2. That Section 66, Non-Parking Areas, of Ordinance No. 30-51, be and the same is hereby amended by the addition of new Paragraph 33, which shall be as follows:

(33) Roosevelt Avenue, from Broad Street to the second alley south of Broad; west side thereof.

Section 3. That existing Paragraph 23 of Section 66 of Ordinance No. 30-51 is hereby repealed.

Section 4. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure because of the urgent necessity for the proper control of traffic, especially near Cassingham School and for the preservation of the public peace, health, welfare and safety and shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
